Spokane Valley City Council - October 10, 2023

Adoption of the City's 2024 Budget follows a system of eight reviews including three public hearings. This evening's regular Spokane Valley City Council meeting commenced with the fifth review and the second of three public hearings on the proposed 2024 Budget. The third and final public hearing will take place on November 21st prior to the adoption of the 2024 Bud-

This hearing, required by state law, is the fifth of eight opportunities for discussion of various aspects of the budget enroute to its final adoption. Of note: The City will once again forego the one percent automatic property tax increase. The \$19,420,397 in budgeted capital expenditures will be partially offset by \$9,507,426 in federal and state grants.

The 2024 recurring revenue estimate is \$62,316,100 which is 10.45% greater than 2023 budget. The recurring expenditure estimate of \$57,976,579 is 7.99% more than the 2023 budget of \$53,532,640. Estimated budgeted recurring revenues currently exceed recurring expenditures by \$4,339,521 or 6.96% of recurring revenues.

The full-time employee count will rise to 116.25, an increase of four employees. Three of those employees will be utilized in administering the Stormwater commitments authorized by Council earlier this year. The fourth will assume additional duties in the accounting department and our recording fee administration program responsibilities.

Funding Challenges:

- The national economy continues to experience volatility, especially the effect of inflation on City projects.
- Revenue levels insufficient to directly cover street operations and maintenance requiring augmentation from the City's General Fund.
- Pavement preservation and railroad crossing projects (overpasses and underpasses) and other large street projects require funding beyond the City's capabilities to provide.
- Establishing a Homeless program and identifying dedicated funding for that program.

As a financial objective, the City intends to in- ing property taxes for 2024 to a second reading passed crease its Service Level Stabilization Reserve Fund to \$8 million from its current level of \$5.5 million as funding becomes available.

This hearing was to gather information, so no action was taken.

Property taxes are a major source of recurring City Revenue representing \$13,824,900 (22.19%) of the City's 2024 budgeted recurring revenue. However, the City actually receives less than 10% of the overall collected property taxes in its jurisdiction. Who then receives the largest portion of those revenues? Three taxing entities compete for that title.

On a \$400,000 home, school districts (education, local and state) and fire districts take the majority. The abbreviated table below defining collections in the Central Valley School District reveals:

State law sets the maximum levy rates for property taxes in a jurisdiction. The formula for calculating the rate is to take the total levy, dividing it by 1,000 and then dividing that number by the total assessed value of the taxing jurisdiction. The County Assessor's Office determines that assessed value. That value currently stands at \$17,576,115,762, producing a levy rate of \$0.786573 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Discussion on whether to take the automatic 1% property tax increase resulted in a spirited discussion. Council once again opted not to take it.

It is probable that new construction after July has not been included in that calculation, thus it's possible that the levy rate might decline. The passage of an ordinance is required to levy and collect 2024 property taxes. That action will be on the October 24th Council Agenda.

The City will collect, based on Spokane County estimated assessments, \$13,745,771 in property tax revenues. The motion to advance Ordinance #23-017, levy5-1 (Mayor Haley was absent).

The City Manager, after an assessment of recent moves affecting receipt and disbursement of City funds, has determined that a new position of Accounting and Finance Program Manager is needed. The new classification will not require an additional full-time employee. The manager would supervise the new staff authorized by Council and oversee the workflow in the City's Outside Agency and Lodging Tax programs. The motion to approve creation of the new Accounting and Finance Manager position was approved unanimously.

A Retail Recruitment update was presented by Community Attributes, Inc. (CAI) on past and recent marketing and recruitment efforts in Spokane Valley.

Tourism is an important part of the City's economy in supporting businesses and creating jobs. The landscape for tourism is constantly changing and increases the need for a strategic plan for competitive action to attract visitors. The City's recently created Tourism Promotion Area (TPA) is designed to develop and maintain such a program. The TPA's first step was to update its destination assessment, including a review of the City's existing tourism assets and infrastructure and a survey of potential tourists and residents.

This action has produced strategy recommendations

- Developing a strong tourism brand
- Investing in marketing and promotion to attract
- Developing tourism products and attractions such as the cross-country course at Flora Park
- Partnering with local businesses and organizations to promote tourism





ECOLOGY OFFERING \$1.8 MILLION IN GRANTS FOR **DROUGHT PREPAREDNESS**

It's time to stop treating droughts like a surprise

Even surprise droughts aren't surprising anymore. Washington has recently seen a pattern of increasing droughts in the face of a warming climate.

In 2015, the state experienced its first severe drought in almost a decade. It was a snow drought, caused when precipitation that traditionally fell as snow, instead fell as rain. It's still considered by many experts to be the "drought of record" — the one to which they compare all other droughts.

In 2019, a drought that started in just a couple of watersheds was eventually expanded to half the state.

In 2021, we had a surprise drought late in the season when a lack of precipitation coupled with a "heat dome" event resulted in a drought declaration that covered most of the Eastern & Central parts of the state.

Also surprising was this year's 2023 drought, when almost half of snowpack was lost in a three-week May heatwave. While in many respects the current drought has been less severe than some others, May through August 2023 has been the 9th driest such period on record — even drier than 2015.

"Droughts are increasing in frequency and severity. We can't lining eligibility and the application process in December of continue to simply react to droughts as they occur," Berns said. 'It's time to invest in climate resiliency for local communities and help them withstand impacts of a changing climate and enhance water security for generations to come."

To jumpstart this work, Ecology will make \$1.8 million available in state-wide grants to incentivize, facilitate, and increase local drought preparedness. Ecology will begin accepting competitive grant applications on January 16, 2024, and will begin issuing these local grants in summer 2024.

The grants will facilitate increased local drought resiliency and water supply security by funding the preparation of "Local Drought Preparedness Plans."

These plans will identify the specific actions, associated costs, and timeframes a local community intends to take to increase its water supply security as the climate changes.

After completing the environmental justice assessment required by the state's historic 2021 Healthy Environment for All Act, Ecology will publish guidance for the grants outthis year.

I am a race car driver born in North Carolina on October 10, 1974. I followed my legendary father into the racing business, but made a name for myself by winning the Daytona 500 twice in my career. I remain one of the most popular drivers of all time.

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Nothing like this Indian Summer weather we've had to get people excited about fishing. Anglers are out in force on the Hanford Reach, plus there's a pretty good fleet of boats looking for walleye on Potholes Reservoir.

My good friend and guide, Brian Nielson, put me and Mike Wren onto so many fish in late September, that we planned another trip to Potholes Reservoir late last week. In spite of the fact that we were fishing during a full moon, we put eleven walleye in the live well, and we only fished for three or four hours. This time Lou Larsen joined us. Larsen is a fly fisher and trolling for walleye was new to him. It didn't take him long to get into the swing of things. He lost a nice walleye right at the boat not long after we got started. Lou and I were trolling sparkly green Smile Blades behind our bottom bouncers. It was a classic Indian Summer day; flat calm, and fishing was tough. We passed near several boats, and they all showed us the "palms up" signal that they weren't getting many fish. Brian took us to several of his hot spots. Our last stop was at the mouth of Lind Coulee. We marked a lot of fish here and got several bites. Lou landed all the walleye we hooked that day. I landed three catfish, and zero walleye. This week's photo is of Brian and Lou.

My wife Eileen and her sister Diane share the same birthday, so for a special treat Diane's husband Tom Verschuren and I took them on an overnight to Winthrop. We stayed at Mt. Gardener Inn and had a great meal at Three Fingered Jacks. After touring the town and lunch, Eileen and I explored the fishing opportunities in the valley. Our first stop was at Pearrygin. This lake has a State Park that can accommodate lots of visitors and is known for its trout fishing in the spring. Bass fishing has become popular here. It is open till the end of October. Our next stop was at Davis Lake, which is southeast of Winthrop. This is a quality lake with selective fishing rules, that is open year-round, with a daily limit of two fish of a minimum size of 14 inches. There is a gravel launch here and internal combustion motors are prohibited. Our last stop was at Little Twin Lake. Big and Little Twin lakes are popular with fly fishers. Both lakes have selective fishing rules and internal combustion motors are prohibited. The daily limit is one fish of a minimum size of 18 inches

There is good news for anglers that are fans of fishing for coho on the upper Columbia River. The river is open to coho retention from above Priest Rapids Dam to Wells Dam and remains open for Chinook. Anglers are allowed to keep two adult Chinook and two coho. All wild Chinook must be released. From Highway 173 Bridge at Brewster to the rock jetty at Foster Creek anglers may also keep two adult Chinook but must release all wild fish and coho. Also, the Icicle River has opened for coho fishing. The recent rain that fell in our region helped a little, but still wasn't enough to draw coho into the Icicle.

I have been checking the river and it is very low and clear, and I have yet to see any signs of coho in the river. I am sure that they are holding up in the deeper holes in the Wenatchee and will rush up when the water levels increase in the Icicle. A new section of the Icicle has been opened this year, too, and will give anglers more water to fish. Please visit the WDFW website and read the most recent release about the Icicle and upper Columbia River updates details.

I am hearing of some great fishing for Chinook in the Hanford Reach. With the one fish limit, anglers are heading home early. Kings are being caught from White Bluffs to Priest Rapids Dam, and off the mouth of Crab Creek below Wanapum Dam. Also, certain areas of the Snake River has opened to fishing.

Lyons Ferry Bubble Fishery from the red river marker (Marker 28) on the south shore of the Snake River upstream to the Highway 261 Bridge, approximately 1.4 miles: Open now, through Oct. 29: Salmon fishing is open Thursdays through Sundays each week. Daily limit is two (2) adult Chinook including no more than one (1) wild (unclipped, adipose intact) adult Chinook. No daily limit for any jack Chinook. Minimum size is 12 inches. Release all salmon other than Chinook. Barbless hooks required.



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River just upstream of West Evans Road on the south shore (approximately three miles downstream of Clarkston) upstream to the Idaho border at Clarkston (the dividing line for catch record card area 648/650): Open now through Oct. 31: Salmon open daily. Salmon daily limit is any three (3) adult Chinook and any two (2) adult coho totaling five (5) adults combined. No limit for any jack Chinook or any jack coho. Minimum size is 12 inches. Barbless hooks required.

Snake River from the Idaho Border at Clarkston (the dividing line for catch record card area 648/650), upstream to the Oregon state line: Open now through Oct. 31: Salmon open daily. Salmon daily limit is any three (3) adult Chinook and any two (2) adult coho, totaling five (5) adults combined. No limit for any jack Chinook or any jack coho. Minimum size is 12 inches. Barbless hooks required.

The Annual King of the Reach Live Capture Fishing Derby is coming up on October 27th to the 29th this year. Unlike traditional fishing tournaments that focus on catching the most or biggest fish, the KOR aims to preserve the future of the Hanford Reach population. Angler participation in this event helps collect natural origin Upriver Bright (URB) fall Chinook salmon, which are incorporated into the broodstock of the Priest Rapids Hatchery (PRH). 

The cold hard fact: Spokane's population has boomed, but we haven't kept up with housing production.

Between 2010 and 2022, the number of households in our housing market area grew by 35,000, or 14%, according to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development. But, the number of housing units built during the same time period only increased by 0.6%. **Spokane is falling behind.**


With a rapidly growing population and limited available land, a key strategy is to increase infill and density. In other words, we need a serious infusion of "middle housing"

By allowing the construction of middle housing options in established neighborhoods, Spokane can significantly increase housing supply.

These smaller, diverse housing types not only provide more options for potential homeowners and renters, but also promote affordability, foster more inclusive communities, and can accommodate various family sizes and income levels.


Currently, Only 2.1% of Spokane's owned housing is considered middle housing. That's less than the average for the state



This is why Building for the Future is advocating for a long-term version of Spokane's Building Opportunity and Choices for All interim ordinance. BOCA was a pilot zoning program approved through July 18, 2023, that modified residential zoning to accelerate construction of more housing options in neighborhoods. Under this interim zoning, construction of middle housing options such as duplexes,

triplexes and townhomes are allowed citywide, as well as, offers incentives for mixed use residential construction.

To keep up with housing demands, it is crucial for Spokane to embrace policies that encourage and facilitate the development of middle housing. By promoting zoning reforms, providing



incentives, and streamlining the approval process, Spokane can unlock the potential of middle housing to meet the diverse needs of our residents while ensuring sustainable and inclusive growth.



HOW TOHire a Remodeling Contractor

SHOP AROUND FOR THE RIGHT COMPANY

- Get at least 3 written estimates.
- Ask for and check references. If possible, look at jobs the contractor recently completed.
- Check with your local chamber of commerce or Better Business Bureau for complaints.
- Be sure that the contractor has the necessary licenses and insurance, as well as the ability to obtain permits.
- Ask if the contractor's workers will do the entire job or whether subcontractors will be involved.

READ THE CONTRACT CAREFULLY

- Be sure the contract states exactly what is to be done and how change orders will be handled.
- Check that the contract states when the work will be completed and what recourse you have if it isn't.
- Make sure the contract indemnifies you if work does not meet building codes or regulations.
- Be sure that the contract specifies who will clean up after the job and be responsible for any damage.
- Ensure that the materials meet your specifications.

SEAL THE DEAL

- Remember that you can often cancel a contract within 3 business days of signing it.
- Make a small down payment so you won't lose much if the contractor fails to complete the job.
- Don't make the final payment until you're satisfied with the work.

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

Classified ads are a great way to sell something, find something or hire a contractor to do needed work around your home or business. Sadly, our advertisers cannot always trust the individuals who respond to their ads. It has come to our attention that there are scammers out there who respond to ads with the sole intention of deceiving the advertiser. Typically these scams are actually generated by automated bots. Here are a few things to look out for:

When selling something:

Scammers typically text & ask what your final price is. They will then ask you if you can ship the item. In return, they tell you that they will send a cashier's check with some extra money added in to cover shipping. Do not fall for this. Accepting cash for items is the best bet. For large purchases, meeting at the buyer's financial institution for the payment is encouraged.

Where to meet:

If you are unsure of a buyer or seller, ask them to meet you at the local police station or S.C.O.P.E. office, or a public location such as a grocery store parking lot. People who don't have anything to hide will be agreeable to that type of meeting spot.

Who to hire:

If you are looking for a contractor to fix or build something, make sure they are licensed & bonded. This can be verified on the Washington State Labor & Industries contractor site. Do not pay in advance for any services or materials until you have a signed contract. Many contractors ask for half the money in advance & the remainder when the job is done. It is good to verify that the individual does, indeed, still work for the company they are representing. It is also a good idea to ask for references. Most contractors are happy to pass on names and phone numbers of customers that can verify their work.
