YOUR CONNECTION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Recent Updates...

Spokane Valley City Council - April 16, 2024

Last week the Spokane Valley City Council attended a retreat in chambers to discuss and set policy goals through 2025. Although the public was invited to attend, no public comment was taken.

The first item of business on the agenda was the First Reading of Ordinance 24-006, the Yellowstone Pipe Line (YPL) Franchise. In November 2021, the City, through Ordinance 21-022, granted YPL Company an extension of its franchise to construct, maintain, and operate its petroleum products pipeline in the City's rights-of-way. In finalizing the design for the City's Pines Road/BNSF rail crossing it became clear that the location of the underpass would materially interfere with the current location of Yellowstone's facilities, which have existed since 1952. Changing the route of that pipeline will be accomplished by rerouting it through property purchased by the City but the change requires amending the existing franchise agreement. This evening, by waiving the rules to speed the process, the amended agreement (Ordinance 24-006) was approved unanimously.

Required facilities moves for the Pines/BNSF project has generated expenses for several purveyors of product and services which involve reimbursement. The Yellowstone Pipeline, which is jointly owned by Phillips 66 and Yellowstone (P66/YPL), has reached agreement with the City on associated pipeline route expenses of \$1,331,304. The motion to approve the reimbursement agreement in that amount passed unanimously.

City Council has the authority to establish its own rules of procedure, policies, and standards of conduct. Such policies and procedures are identified in its Governance Manual. As times, rules and procedures change, the manual is periodically updated. The proposed changes brought forward by the Governance Manual Committee address in part the following:

- Unacceptable Councilmember behavior, leaving a meeting unexcused, engaging in, or encouraging disruptive behavior from the public seating area.
- Removal of per diem for travel expenses, change of policy for reimbursement for meals/lodging costs related to travel for city business. Removal of monthly mileage stipend.

The City Municipal Code must be amended to provide the Hearing Examiner with authority to preside over hearings contesting an investigator's findings and conclusions of misconduct as well as procedural rules for such hearings.

The motion to approve Resolution 24-006, repealing the existing manual and replacing it with the revised one passed 6-1 (Merkel-no).

The Clean Building Law was passed in the State Legislature in 2022. The Department of Commerce has developed energy performance standards for non-residential buildings. For performance measuring purposes, the categories have been designated as Tier 1: Buildings having a gross area between 20,000 and 50,000 square feet; and Tier 2: Buildings having a gross area exceeding 50,000 square feet.

The law is aimed at reducing carbon pollution by establishing energy use intensity targets specific to Washington. Compliance steps include processes for measuring and tracking energy use using at least 12 consecutive months of data per building.

City buildings affected are CenterPlace (56,055 sq ft), City Hall (65,299 sq ft), and the Police Precinct (22,020 sq ft). Benchmark measurements for City Hall and CenterPlace have been completed. While City Hall meets the requirements, CenterPlace does not. An energy audit will be required to determine the most cost-effective measures to achieve the mandated standards. The audit is estimated to cost \$40,000.

Staff is exploring two potential funding opportunities to help offset the cost of the audit and other plan requirements. The first is an Energy Efficiency Revolving and Conservation Formula (EERCF). The second is a State Department of Commerce (Commerce) Clean Building Audit Incentive Program. EERCF applications are due by April 30th, 2024. Commerce applications are accepted up to April 20th, 2025. Council reached consensus to authorize applying for both.

Each year amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan are proposed for addition to the Comprehensive Plan Docket. Two such amendments were proposed for 2024, both by the City, and both were map amendments. The first, (CPA-2024-01) is for property owned by Spokane Conservation District located at 4418 East 8th Avenue and would change 44 acres from Multi-Family Residential (MFR) to Mixed Use. An additional piece would change 5.2 acres from MFR to Single-Family residential (SFR). The second proposed plan amendment (CPA-2024-02) would change 0.83 acres owned by Family Promise of Spokane at 17103 E. Main Avenue from SFR to Corridor Mixed Use. The Planning Commission held study sessions on the proposed amendments and recommended passage of the first amendment but denied the second. Council reached consensus to move CPA-2024-1 to a first reading and withdraw the application for CPA-2024-02. Spokane Valley City Council meetings are held in City Hall, 10210 E. Sprague Avenue, on Tuesdays, commencing at 6:00pm. City Hall is open for regular business during normal business hours (8:00am to 5:00pm). The Public is invited to Council meetings to participate in action items or public comment periods in person or via ZOOM. Call 509-720-5000 or prior to 4:00 p.m. for access instructions. Council meetings are broadcast on Comcast channel 14.

- Addition of mileage reimbursement according to current IRS mileage rates.
- Addition of a description of the Public Safety Committee.
- Addition of policies to address compliance requirements and enforcement procedures.
- Addition of policies regarding photocopies, out of state travel, dress code and volunteer/legislative assistants.
- Addition of a policy that tracks costs for a social media archiving platform shall be deducted from each Councilmember's individual annual budget.
- Addition of policies and penalties for posting false information to social media. A new Chapter 5 defining standards of conduct for Council members and providing procedures for alleged violations to be investigated and presented to Council for action is included. These procedures gives an accused Councilmember the opportunity to request a hearing before the City Hearing Examiner to contest an investigator's findings and conclusions that violations occurred.

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

The following is the title and summary of Ordinance No. 24-006 passed by the Spokane Valley City Council on the 16th day of April 2024 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPOKANE VALLEY, SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMEND-ING, MODIFYING, AND SUPPLE-MENTING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 21-022, RELATING TO GRANTING A NON-EXCLU-SIVE FRANCHISE TO THE YEL-LOWSTONE PIPE LINE COMPA-NY TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REMOVE, REPLACE, AND REPAIR EXISTING PIPELINE FACILITIES FOR THE TRANSPOR-TATION OF PETROLEUM PROD-UCTS AND BYPRODUCTS WITH. IN AND THROUGH THE CITY OF SPOKANE VALLEY, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the Franchise granted to Yellowstone in Ordinance 21 022 by expanding the original Grant of Franchise to accommodate the relocation of Yellowstone's facilities from the BNSF rail corridor to the city-owned Spokane County parcel number 45033.5010, which is the subject of a capital improvement project involving the grade separation of Pines Road. 



This was a great week for fishing, especially for kids. The Banks Lake Triple Fish Challenge started last Friday, and they set up a fishing pond and there were some whoppers landed by the youngsters. On Saturday the 20th Rock Island is hosting a free kids fishing day at the Pit Pond. This is a great event.

The Annual Banks Lake Triple Fish Challenge that took place last weekend was a resounding success. Reel Recreation, the group that organizes and stages the event did an excellent job, conducting a quality event. The sixty participants enjoyed sunny skies and calm water and turned in record

numbers of triple fish catches. Anglers that had been able to catch a walleye, bass, trout or whitefish in a single day had been rare in the past. This year eight anglers accomplished this feat, and six on Sunday. The overall fishing was very good on Saturday, but more difficult on Sunday, particularly for walleye. There were different winners for biggest fish of each species on Saturday and Sunday, for both adults and youth. The biggest stringer on Sunday was turned in by Jim

Stanely at 5.68 pounds. The combined best stringer weight for both days was 14.44 pounds and was turned in by Brian Waters. He won the grand prize, which was a tricked out kayak valued at \$3,000. Cash and prizes for the biggest fish of each species was awarded each day of the Challenge. For complete details and you can visit the Reel Recreation website or Facebook page. The opening day of trout fishing season is coming up later this month. There are several events planned on our year round waters, and they are typically focused on getting kids and their families out fishing. There are a couple of them planned for the third Saturday in April every year. One that I helped with over 25 years ago takes place in Rock Island at the Pit Pond. The City of Rock Island does some landscaping clean up and tidies up the shorelines in anticipation of the crowds that show up. Local volunteers will be serving donuts and coffee in the morning and hot dogs, snacks, and soft drinks later in the day. Members of the Wenatchee Sportsman Association will be at the event with loaner rods and tackle and bait for the kids to use. The City of Rock Island and the local volunteers have made this into something folks look forward to every year. Also, on the same day and going on at least as long as the Rock Island event, is the Rotary Club kids fishing day at Oasis Park in Ephrata. The ponds at both locations are loaded with fresh trout to assure the kids will catch a few.

My friend Dennis Beich invited me to join him



for a morning of fishing on Billy Clapp Lake last Friday. We had fished there a couple of weeks ago, and only got one fish, so we wanted to give it another try. Usually, we get a lot of nice rainbow on Billy Clapp this time of year. We made our way up the lake to the area above the big basalt island, and there were fish rising everywhere. There was some kind of hatch going on and the fish were actively feeding. Maybe that's why they weren't interested in what we were offering them. We trolled all kinds of plugs, and Dennis even tried trolling a fly, and still nothing. So, we put our trout gear away and pulled out our walleye gear and headed up to the top end of the lake. This is where we have both caught walleye in the past. There were three or four other boats fishing in the same area, but no one was catching anything. It may be too early. I will use this for an excuse anyway. We still had a great time. It was a beautiful day to be on the water.

Can you ever have enough triploids

in the freezer for smoking? My buddies and I don't think so, and we made another trip to the middle net pens on Rufus Woods. James Lebow, Ryan Harris, and Michael Ericson joined me, and we had high hopes. The four of us have limited in a short time here in the past. Not on Wednesday. We gave it up after about three hours with just one fish. On my way back I stopped at Seatons Grove to see if many boats had launched there. I walked down to the boat ramp and saw the tell tale swirl of a fish on the surface, so I grabbed a rod, cast it out and jammed it hard into some rocks. I went to my truck to get

> out of my warm clothes, and when I looked down to check my rod--it was gone! A fish had pulled it into the water. I had another rod rigged and started casting in hope of snagging it. It was dead calm, and I saw it on the bottom. I hooked the rod, pulled it in and there was a fish on the line-and I landed a 6 pound triploid! This week's photo is of the fish I landed. Typically, by this

time of year the water temperatures in our reservoirs have warmed enough to get the walleye bite going. I looked at a photo taken at this time of year on Moses Lake that showed me with a 20 inch walleye. It was landed from across Connelly Park. Connelly Park which is open for the season. The park is open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m., but it is closed on Monday and Tuesday through the month of April. I like to use this launch as it is the closest to the upper end of Moses Lake and that's where the action starts in the spring. On Potholes Reservoir, many anglers make their first trips for walleye on Lind Coulee. There has been some significant improvements to the Samsons Pit launch, which is just below the mouth of Lind Coulee, at the far eastern side of O'Sullivan Dam. My friends and I have had some good days in the early spring on Potholes in the Coulee. I am not sure if the docks are in at the State Park. The lake level should allow for launching at Blythe, which is just down the shore from the State Park toward Mar Don.

REPUBLIC RACE TRACK HOPES FOR JUNE OPENING

REPUBLIC, Wash. — Better late than not at all.

Eagle Track Raceway in Republic plans to operate in 2024, but just somewhat delayed.

With former track promoter Jason Pestka deciding to no longer operate the track, the Eagle Track Racing Association is stepping back into running the nearly 70-year-old 3/8's mile dirt raceway.

Everything became official April 8 when the Ferry County Commissioners agreed to let ETRA operate the track which the county owns.

Eagle Track Racing Association is the group that built and started the track decades ago according to Wendy Braun who is spearheading opening the track.

"Looking at June for the first race if we have everything we need," ETRA spokesperson Braun wrote in an email.

This effort reunites ETRA and Braun who both have deep raceway roots. The ETRA has ran the track back when

it started in the 1950s. "I myself started coming and racing at the track back in the 90's," Braun said. "I have many relatives that have raced at the track, uncles, cousins, my dad and myself."

ETRA is a non-profit organization composed of officers and a board of directors.

The association has been behind a myriad of upgrades and improvements over the years. Back in 2015 the ETRA did all the upgrades around the track including new buildings, opened up and added more spectator parking, moved and enlarged the pit area.

"I know the county was working on a grant for lights, but I haven't been updated on that as of right now," Braun said.

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
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
