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


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

WATER FOR ALL - PART 1

As the rains have returned to Washington and stormwater is flowing, we're reminded of the important role stormwater management plays in keeping rivers, streams, lakes, and Puget Sound clean. Ecology has <u>municipal stormwater permits</u> for the state's most populated cities and counties. The permits are aimed at reducing stormwater pollution at its source, treating it, and

controlling volume and flow, so that cleaner stormwater is entering local waterways.

Meet SAM, Washington's Stormwater Action Monitoring Collective

One of the most innovative parts of Washington's approach to stormwater management is the <u>Stormwater Action Monitoring (SAM) Collective</u>. Since its start nearly a decade ago in 2014, SAM brings together municipal stormwater permittees from the state's most populated cities and counties to collaborate on stormwater monitoring and management. SAM's goal is to improve stormwater management in Washington.

We are currently in the process of soliciting and assessing proposals for the fourth round of funded studies. Several new studies will begin in 2024. Keep reading to learn more about SAM's successes. To help improve stormwater management, SAM runs 3 types of studies:



Effectiveness studies

Measure the impact of stormwater management actions to determine what works and what doesn't.

Source identification studies,

We're learning which actions are successful in preventing illicit discharges and reducing pollutants to stormwater.

A stormwater bioretention facility in Olympia.

All stormwater permittees benefit from SAM

SAM was created with the understanding that through a collective effort, we can improve stormwater management actions to better protect and restore Washington's waters. No other permit-driven monitoring program in the state is defined and funded by permittees. Permittees are critical to selecting relevant studies and ensuring results are actionable. SAM studies address important permit-related topics, like designing and retrofitting stormwater facilities, reducing tire wear particles (including 6PPD) and PCBs, and improving local business inspection programs. All jurisdictions — large and small —benefit from SAM projects that produce regionally transferable findings. This means that all permittees can implement SAM findings to protect downstream waters such as lakes, streams, and bays.

SAM's source identification studies are focused on learning which actions by permittees and businesses are successful in preventing illicit discharges of pollutants to stormwater.

• Source Control & Inspection Program Guidance – In 2019, Ecology required Municipal Stormwater Phase II permittees to develop and implement a source control business and site inspection program. A 2023 SAM study developed a Source Control Inspection Program Guidance Manual and training program. The guidance manual and training resources are available online at no cost, providing access to municipal stormwater staff and other stormwater professionals in the region. Long-term regional status and trends monitoring studies, We're learning whether our collective stormwater management actions are improving streams and marine waters.

How does SAM work?

Municipal stormwater permittees choose to join SAM and pay into the collective fund. The <u>Stormwater Work Group (SWG)</u>, a formal stakeholder group, makes decisions on how to spend these pooled funds. We partner with other agencies and stormwater professionals to conduct Best Management Practice (BMP) effectiveness studies, source identification studies, and monitor the status and long-term trends of water quality. Ecology has two staff members dedicated to implementing SAM. The Pooled Resources Oversight Committee, a subgroup of the SWG, oversees Ecology's administration of SAM.

By learning together, we can achieve far more than by funding studies individually. We all benefit by answering regionally relevant stormwater questions. Our understanding, and our responses to improve and manage stormwater, are coming faster and more efficiently than before SAM.

I am sure that the freezing temperatures kept most people close to hearth and home this past week. Conditions were great for those who were drilling holes in the ice on some of the lakes at higher elevation. When you are prepared for severely cold weather, you can still have a blast. I fished Georgetown Lake in Montana when it was eight below zero and had great fun. Ice fishing continues to grow in popularity every year. More and more people are finding this activity a great way to spend a day in the winter.

Dang is it cold. Way too cold to fish effectively from the shore or in a boat. The good news is that lakes that already had a thin layer of ice may now be fishable. Some of the lakes at high-

er elevation, like Sidley, near Oroville, and Bonaparte, near Tonasket, have had safe ice for a few weeks. I talked to the folks at Tiffany's Resort on Curlew Lake, near Republic, and they told me that the lake near them just froze over, but it is six inches thick off the State Park. A couple of their guests fished there the day before and came back with a five gallon bucket full of nice perch. Tiffany's has a few rooms available on the weekends, but they are going fast. There are plenty of week days open, though. Patterson Lake should have a good layer of ice on it with the sub-zero temperatures, but I would check with folks at the Tenderfoot or the Outdoorsman to see if people are fishing yet. I am sure that ice has formed on Moses Lake, but I doubt it is thick enough to support a group of anglers. I would say the same about Fish Lake, near Leavenworth. This week's photo is of me at Fish Lake in early February two seasons ago.

I was planning to do some shore fishing at Brandts Landing this week, until I saw the single digit forecasts for the region. When temperatures as this low, you just can't fish. Believe me I have tried. When the line freezes to the spool, casting is impossible. I did make a call to my contact about the fishing on Rufus Woods. Dave checks anglers that are fishing above Chief Joseph Dam, all the way up to Brandts Landing. He isn't enforcement, as he only monitors angler success for the Colville Tribe. The first thing he told me was to clarify

the number of fish that were recently release. There were rumors that there were 16,000 fish put in Rufus Woods, but the actual number is 1,600. They put 800 fish in at Seatons Grove and another 800 were released from the State Park above the dam. The fish weigh 3 to 6 pounds and a few have been caught from the shore above Chief Joseph. Most anglers are catching two categories of fish at the lower end of the reservoir. One group of fish are just 12 inchers, and the others are 2.5 to 3.5 pounds. I'll try it when the weather warms up a bit. This is the time of year that I usually have pretty good success at Brandts Landing. It's one of my favorite winter destinations for fishing from shore.



Looking at the forecasts for the week, I still see some very cold temperatures coming. That's great news for fans of ice fishing, and not so great news for people like me that want to fish from shore or in a boat. I have finally put together my cold weather wardrobe that keeps me warm even when the outside temperature is very low. We are fortunate that there is gear available to us that makes fishing in extreme cold weather possible. I have a heated jacket made by Ororo that works great. I recommend these to people and to just get the vest. You get the same heated panels and more freedom of movement. People should understand that you need a layer over the jacket or vest. I have some terrifically warm Columbia Sportswear "Omni Heat" jackets that I put on over my heated coat, and I will often put on a light rain jacket over this as a final layer to block the wind. I have a pair of heated socks made by Begleri that have three settings and keep my toes and feet warm. I put them inside my Muck Artic Sport boots. I know people that have heated socks and can turn them on and off and even change the heat settings with a remote. My winter under wear is from Grays Harbor Unders, and I pull on some

Columbia Sportswear rain pants over my lined pants. Bring it on winter. I am ready for your worst!

The Bonaparte Lake Resort's 2nd Annual Ice Fishing Derby is coming up next weekend. It is scheduled for Saturday, January 27th. The event attracted almost 400 people last year, and this year they accumulated cash and prizes valued at over \$9,000. Entry fees are \$15 for adults, \$30 for an adult and multi-species ticket. The entry fee for youth under age 15, is \$15. You can register the day of the event from 5:30 to 9:30 a.m. You can register on line by going to the Bonaparte Lake Resort Facebook page and use the QR Code on the page. If you register on line you are required to get a wrist band from the resort. Weigh in is from 7:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., and you must be in line no later than 4 p.m. The event is going to be fun for the whole family. So, drag out your ice fishing gear and warmest clothes and plan to join the fun!

When you plan to go outside in minus zero temperatures be prepared. With wind chill factors at minus 20 degrees at times, you need to be sure you don't have any exposed skin. It can frostbite in less than ten minutes! I haven't bought an ice fishing shack yet, but this may be the winter to do it. Nothing like being out of the wind with a Little Buddy propane heater to keep me warm. I am jealous of those who have them, like by brother-in-law in Montana. He and his wife often fish in temperatures that are often double digit, sub-zero, and have a great time.

Wildfire season is months away, but new permanent rules for wildfire smoke went into effect on January 15, 2024.

New Workplace Rules for Wildfire Smoke Safety

The new permanent business safety rules for wildfire smoke include several new requirements that increase as air quality levels grow worse.

According to the Department of Labor & Industries Wildfire Smoke & Workplace Safety and Health webpage, at a minimum, all covered employers must:

- · Prepare a written wildfire smoke response plan.
- · Provide wildfire smoke training to employees.
- Watch the PM2.5 conditions and forecasts.
- · Prepare a two-way communication system.
- Make provisions for prompt medical treatment, and permit that treatment without retaliation.

As air quality levels worsen to an Air Quality Index (AQI) of 69-100, employers must:

- Notify employees of the PM2.5 conditions
- Make sure only trained employees work outdoors
- · Consider implementing exposure controls
- Consider using voluntary use respirators

When the AQI is between 101-300, employers must also:

- · Make N95 respirators available for voluntary use
- Implement exposure controls, like:
 - Providing enclosed buildings, structures, or vehicles where the air is adequately filtered.
 - Providing portable HEPA filters in enclosed areas.
- Relocating work to a location with a lower smoke level.
- Changing work schedules to a time with a lower smoke level.
- Avoiding or reducing work that creates additional dust, fumes, or smoke (for example limiting welding, sanding, sawing, spray painting, etc.).
- Reducing work intensity.
- Providing additional rest periods.

The requirements continue to increase as the AQI increases beyond 301. More information is available on the L&I website.

Areas of Concern

The Building Insdustry Association of Washington (BIAW) is proud of our work to help employers keep their job sites safe and healthy, particularly participants in the ROII program. We'll continue to work to help builders comply with these rules to keep themselves and their workers safe.

We did, however, voice concerns about these new rules, including:

- · Confusing and complex air quality monitoring requirements. Air quality tools can cover vast amounts of area with ranging differences in air quality. It's unclear and could result in unnecessary action and/or slowdowns at a time when our state needs us building more homes, not less.
- · Similarly unclear training requirements. Annual training is required but it's unclear whether a worker must receive training at every job site or just once a year. Clarity is important.
- Mandatory respirators for voluntary use. Finally, the rule requires mandatory respirators for voluntary use at an AQI of 101, which is only unhealthy for sensitive groups, not the average healthy individual. We recommend rather than applying this rule to all, only apply it to those who self-identify with a health sensitivity and allow them a respirator as requested.



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As we receive more guidance from L&I, we will provide more information to help you comply and keep your workplaces safe during fire season.

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
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Real Estate Trends & Advice

LANDLOCKED



For the second time in a week I've come across the situation where someone owns a property that is landlocked. That means there is no legal recorded easement for the owner to access their property, even though there may be some sort of a road in place and history of use. This makes such property virtually worthless. How does this happen? This scenario is most often created when the owner of a larger parcel sells off portions of their property without reserving an easement for the remaining parcel. The next question is, "If the current owner is not the one who unintentionally landlocked their own property, then why didn't the new buyer discover that issue when they purchased it?"

Real estate brokers and attorneys are often called in to help cure this significant type of title defect after a do-it-yourselfer has self inflicted this situation on themselves and then passed that issue on to the next owner without a title search. Title insurance might seem inexpensive to that owner now that this truth is discovered.

The good news is that according to the Revised Code of Washington a property cannot be landlocked (RCW 8.24.010). That is not to say that the cure is quick and easy, but if the affected party has the gumption to take it to court, a judge would likely find that you are entitled to an easement and subsequently award an easement by necessity, though you would have to pay the fair value for the easement, including loss of opportunity for the neighbor.

Since filing a court action against a neighbor usually creates ill-will, a better approach may be to diplomatically convince the neighbor(s) of your need for access and be willing to pay the going rate to create that written easement. Threats of a future lawsuit may not be the way to start that conversation.

Things that affect a neighbor's willingness to cooperate are the attitude of the petitioner of course, and the revelation as to what the access agreement will need to consist of. Will the affected property be subdivided in the future, creating more traffic, which could mean more dust and headache for the neighbor?

The current owner could potentially sue the previous owner for conveying this defective title, but that would just take more time and create more cost, adding layers to the possible solution. Honestly a buyer who purchases property without the clarity of a Title Insurance Policy probably deserves exactly what they get.

first race, setting fast time, which would put us starting on the pole. "We led from the green flag to checkered flag," Suchy said.


This would be his only two wins at Hermiston, but the rest of the races Suchy would finish in the top five, which kept him in the points lead for the entire season.

The Irrigon, Oregon driver ended with an eight -point cushion over Hermiston's David Knowles.




