
My plan for last Thursday was to run down to Rocky Ford Creek to fish for big trout with my fly rod. The weather was going to be warm enough that my line wouldn't freeze to my guides, and I hadn't done any fishing for way too long. Then disaster struck. My wife went into

our garage, which is actually a storage area, and found water on the floor. I went out and started mopping up, and we soon figured out that we had a major problem. The radiant heating system had frozen, broke the pipe and cracked the concrete surface. No amount of mopping was going to keep up with the water coming up through the floor. So, we spent much of the night moving things that could be damaged, which are still stacked in our living room. Plumbers came to our rescue and did the needed repairs, and I was able to go fishing on Friday.

When I arrived, I was the only rig in the upper parking lot, but two other anglers

arrived shortly after. Usually, the best part of my day on Rocky Ford Creek is landing the first big rainbow. Last Friday was different. The two anglers I met in the parking lot was the best part of my day. First to arrive was Kelly Rupp, from Snohomish. He was a real fan of fishing Rocky Ford, and he was waiting for his friend Ron Romig, from Kettle Falls. These two meet to fish the Ford regularly, but it had been two years since the pair had been able to make the trip. When Ron rolled into the parking lot, it was a quite a scene as the two friends greeted each other. I could tell that they shared a lot of history and some great times together. Ron walked over and said that he was a long-time follower of my reports and E-Letters, and we had communicated several times over the years, and he was glad that we would finally meet face to face. Before I left I caught up with the pair and got to learn more about the kinds of fishing the two of them love to do. One of the places that they raved about was Twin Lakes on the Colville Indian Reservation. I haven't fished this lake for years. I may even join them for a day there next spring. This week's photo is of the two anglers I met at the Ford last Thursday.

These two anglers like to fish the very top end of Rocky Ford and cast dry flies to the big trout that are milling around above the bridge. I like to fish well below here. I find places to cast at the edge



of the reeds. This makes casting very difficult, and I have to track my flies down in the reeds when I hesitate too long and let my back cast fall. I think I have better luck in these areas, though, as I don't think many anglers will put up with the hassle.

Well, my theory didn't pan out so much. I didn't get a bite and didn't see a fish rise all day where I was fishing. This was very unusual. Typically, I at least see some fish when I step up to the bank. Nobody was home on this particular day. Since I need to find something to blame on my poor success, I will blame the full moon this time.

If you keep your eyes peeled you can see some interesting things in the winter. I sometimes take a detour on the way to the post office in Leavenworth and spot a small flock of turkeys on the road to the ski hill. I saw them earlier this week in the same place, and later in the week in a completely different location. This particular flock has been around for years, and I have seen them numerous times. There seems to be about a dozen in this group. A couple of days later, as I was approaching my driveway I saw another flock of turkeys. There were about 20 of them. I have never seen this bunch before. They hung around in our side yard, and as I walked along the house to get closer look at them I found tracks clear around the house into the front yard. Also, we have a doe and two


yearling mule deer that are in our yard year-round. They are quite used to us, and one even licked a chunk of ice in my hand last summer. I am now seeing other deer bedded down in the orchards as the snow has become very deep here in Leavenworth.

The spike in ice fishing activity at Fish Lake and the Columbia Basin was short-lived. The severely cold weather was followed closely by warm weather and thinned the ice to the point where it just isn't safe. I am getting reports that the same is true at the lakes that are at lower elevations in Okanogan County. I visited Fish Lake on January 20th, and there was enough

safe ice to provide good fishing for over sixty people that I saw there at that time. However, on the following Monday I talked to someone that had actually fallen through the ice on Fish Lake. The ice is shrinking back from the shore and there is slush and water on the surface of most of the lakes now. Both Curlew Lake and Bonaparte Lake in the northern part of the state had very thick layers of ice on them and it would take a lot of warm weather to thin the ice to unsafe conditions, and I will be monitoring these as best I can.

I am really looking forward to a planned trip to Rufus Woods Reservoir. My friends have invited me along to try for big triploids and walleye at the upper end. Wish us luck!

10 TIPS FOR A SMOOTH HOME REMODEL



1. Establish effective two-way communication with the home remodeler

It's essential to have good communication for a smooth home remodeling project. Does the remodeler listen? Does he or she answer questions clearly and candidly? Can you reach him when you need to? Does he return phone calls promptly? Does he let you know when problems arise and work with you on solving them?

- 2. Make sure you are compatible with the contractor You'll spend a lot of time with your remodeler so it's important to have a good rapport and trust in him or her.
- 3. Set a clear and mutual understanding about the schedule

You and your home remodeler should agree on the schedule up front to avoid conflict and problems later in the project.

4. Request a written proposal

Often, two people remember the same conversation differently. Get the proposal in writing and work with the remodeler to ensure it reflects your wishes.

5. Get a clear and mutual understanding on miscellaneous details up front

There are a lot of little details that need to be settled before work starts. What times of day will they be working? How will he or she access the property? How will cleanup be handled? How will they protect your property?

6. Remember to be flexible

Remodeling is an interruption of your normal life. Remember to be flexible during the project so that you can handle the unexpected and go with the flow.

7. Discuss and agree on how change orders will be handled

With home remodeling there is always the chance you may want to change materials or other project details during the job. Before work starts, make sure you agree with your remodeler about how these changes will be handled. Also understand that changes could affect the schedule and the budget, so it's important you have all changes in writing.

8. Agree on a well-written contract that covers all the bases

The contract should include these elements: a timetable for the project, price and payment schedule, detailed specifications for all products and materials, insurance information, permit information, procedures for handling change orders, lien releases, provisions for conflict resolution, notice of your right under the Federal Trade Commission's Cooling Off Rule (your right to cancel the contract within three days if it was signed someplace other than the remodeler's place of business), and details on the important issues (such as access to your home, care of the home, cleanup and trash removal).

9. Ask for a written lien waiver from the home remodeler upon completion of the work

If the remodeler hires subcontractors for portions of the work, then it is their responsibility to see the subcontractors compensated. In order to ensure this has been done and to protect yourself, ask for a written lien waiver when the work is finished. This document will



New Hydrology Study Provides Recommendations

The challenges of high water and flooding around Sprague Lake are complex. To help unravel the issues and identify flood risk solutions, the state legislature directed funds to us, in partnership with Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW).

Now, an extensive new hydrology study over the past year, conducted by a private consulting firm, recommends focusing on flood preparedness planning, temporary flood-fighting techniques, zoning, and building code enforcement.

"We know how difficult recurring high-water levels and flooding have been for those around Sprague Lake," said Brook Beeler, Ecology's Eastern Region director. "The results and recommendations from this study provide a science-based path forward that will help the community be better prepared for future events."

Results and Recommendations

The hydrology study found that most of the rainwater carried by Sprague Lake's main tributary, Negro Creek, goes underground, and only a small amount stays on the surface. Long periods of heavy rain or spring snowmelt are the main causes of high-water levels in the lake, which limits the lake's capacity to accommodate additional flow from Negro Creek. Because of this, the study looked at different ways to prevent flooding, including making Cow Creek wider or changing the piping infrastructure of a water-control structure located at the lake's Cow Creek outlet. The study also explored bigger changes, like creating an 80-foot-wide channel or a bypass channel between the Sprague Lake outlet and Danekas Road.



"As a manager of land on Sprague Lake, WDFW remains committed to working with the local community to find a solution to the flooding issue that has impacted the area," said Brock Hoenes, regional director for WDFW's North Central – Region 2.

The study recommends that to help protect property and infrastructure in the event of flooding, the City of Sprague and Lincoln and Adams counties (Sprague Lake straddles the county line) could instead further the strategies identified in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers 2020 report, City of Sprague Nonstructural Flood Mitigation Assessment. These include:

ERIC WOLFE - QLISPE RACEWAY 2023 PRO ELIMINATOR CHAMPION

Eric Wolfe can trace his drag racing roots back to not far after what was then Spokane Raceway Park — now Qlispe Raceway — opened in 1974.

But it was not until 2023 that he won his first track championship with the title in Pro Eliminator. Wolfe parlayed a couple on event wins into securing a 292 to 240 edge over T.J. Loper.

Racing two classes, Pro and Sportsman, Wolfe said. "In sportsmen this year, I just couldn't do squat," he lamented.

However, "In Pro it fell the right way, I won," Wolfe said. "I think I was in three finals in a row and won two of them, so it was pretty decent."

Wolfe, who actually lives in Fife, Washington near Tacoma and commutes to race in QRP's Summit Series, first began racing at age 16 in 1980 while a student at University High School in Spokane Valley.

"I remember that was back and when we had (classes like) Run Tuff and stuff," Wolfe said. "So yeah, there's just good times." Wolfe raced then with and against classmate and best friend Bruce Nickerson, and still does.

Like many, Wolfe raced until family obligations got in the way in 1987 and took a hiatus until 1999. He competed for about a dozen years, hanging it up once again in 2011 only to come back again a decade later.

While no relation, Eric Wolfe used to race against a very stout competitor, Henrietta Wolfe, at Spokane Raceway in the 1980s.

"Henrietta kicked my ass at one of the AHRA World Finals, I think it was (19)87?," Eric said. "That's why I retired," he suggested.

Wolfe not just raced at Spokane but also Walla Walla's eighth-mile track. The convenient part for him is his car was stored at his mother's house in Spokane which cut down the expensive towing just a bit.

And talk about a dedicated racer, Wolfe

It was during that time Wolfe recalled one of his memorable outings in the 2009 NHRA Division 6 ET Finals Race of Champions at Woodburn Dragstrip in Oregon. It was an all-Spokane final round where

"It was killing me," Wolfe said. "When the "Q" (Qlispe Raceway) opened up, I was really happy. It was just bonus to do good in Pro (Eliminator) this year on the hill," he added referencing the nickname for the Airway Heights racing complex.

Wolfe turned 60 this past December and works for Dow Jones. He has grown kids who both like hot rods and his youngest races every-once-in-a-while.
